Typically Banks, Building Societies, Insurance Companies, Supermarkets, Utility Companies, Phone Companies and Car Manufacturers are all known to offer match-funding schemes so please do ask your company if they do this it can make a huge difference to our fundraising and <u>every single</u> penny that FoGMS raises goes directly back to resources for the students at GMS.

Barclays, for example, offers its employees the opportunity to match funds they raise for their chosen charity up to £750 per year. This is available for three activities a year! Aviva, in response to feedback from their staff, has introduced a '£Plus' matching scheme. The scheme gives Aviva employees the chance to receive matched funds for any money raised on behalf of a registered charity of their choice.

Total raised by FOGMS during school year 2021-2022 was £20,989.10

A few examples of the many additional resources funded just in the past 3 years by FoGMS for all the students at GMS are:

- A new projector in the drama department M10 room which is used by all students.
- A donation of £7,500 towards the new garden room reflection and learning space
- Logo/d sweatshirts for the Sports Leaders programme
- All inclusive OUTDOOR SEATING for the students to be able to sit, eat and relax in the school grounds
- 6 x outdoor Table tennis tables
- Drinking fountain in the Canteen area with chilled water access for all the children.
- Ongoing leases for the two minibuses at an annual cost of £11,040.
- PE cycling initiative which has proved incredibly popular with the students was given £3,250.

The Minibuses are continually in use and FoGMS has an ongoing yearly commitment to raise the fund to pay for the lease of these vehicles.
