Year 11 An Inspector Calls trip

The English Department have an exciting opportunity for Year 11 students to attend a trip to see a production of *An Inspector Calls* at the Aylesbury Waterside Theatre. *An Inspector Calls* is a set text for your child's English Literature GCSE. The trip is designed to give students an understanding of the play as it is intended to be seen, i.e. on a stage rather than a tv/movie adaptation. This trip is also an enriching experience to provide our students with the opportunity to attend a professionally directed and performed production of an excellent modern play. We aim to accommodate any student needs as far as is possible.

The date of the trip will be **Thursday 28th November 2024** and the proposal of the day is as follows:

18:00-19:00: Travel via coach from GMS

21:30-22:30: Travel back to GMS via coach
