Dear Year 11 Parents/ Carers

I am writing to inform you that we are offering students in Year 11 the opportunity to spend some additional time in school on Monday 7th – Wednesday 9th April 2025.

We have put together a programme of subject-based revision sessions over these three days, designed to positively engage children across the range of their curriculum subjects. These sessions have been planned in order to prepare students for their terminal examinations. We, as a school, see this as a good opportunity to provide additional support for our Year 11 students.

Attendance is optional and students who do not attend will not miss out on any planned curriculum delivery; this will take place during term time as normal. The activities delivered during these three days will be subject-based revision sessions. Each day will start at 8.45am and consist of three different subject-based sessions lasting one hour and 15 minutes each, with 2x fifteen-minute breaks between sessions 1 and 2, and 2 and 3. All days will end at 1pm. A timetable of these sessions may be found on the following page of this letter so you can see which sessions are being offered and when.

The school canteen will not be open for the three days so students will need to bring their own snacks and drinks for the day. Students do not need to wear school uniform. Students can choose to attend any of the three days offered.
