CAREERS IN SPORT LIVE: BTEC Sport and A-Level PE Trip

Your son/ daughter has a very exciting opportunity to attend a Carers in Sport Live! event at the G-Tech Community Stadium, home to Brentford Football Club. We aim for the trip to be inclusive of all students, regardless of need.

The trip will run on Thursday 19th March. Students will need to leave school at 8:30 am and will return around 4/ 4:30 pm. We recommend that your son / daughter brings a packed lunch with them as there may not be food available. Students will be expected to catch up on any work missed. Students need to wear Sixth Form 'business wear'.

Although this trip is not compulsory, it is highly recommended as it is a brilliant opportunity to develop knowledge and understanding of sport in the workplace.

We will be asking for a voluntary contribution of £18. This includes entry to the event and travel. There is no obligation to contribute and no student will be treated differently should a parent / carer be unable or unwilling to pay. However, the trip may not be able to go ahead if we receive insufficient contributions.

We only have 15 tickets available so not all students will be able to attend. At this stage, we would ask that you complete this [Expression of interest](#) by 9 am on Monday 12th January if your son / daughter is interested. If there is more interest than we have tickets available, student

names will be drawn randomly. An email will then be sent to the parents / carers of students who have been successful, explaining what then needs to be done to secure the ticket.

The students will be supervised for the majority of the time, however during the networking sessions students will have opportunities to meet a number of exhibitors. They will need to remain in groups of 3 at all times and at no point should they leave the stadium. Staff will be stationed at set points that students are aware of and students will have the school mobile phone number if there were to be an issue.
