A very Happy New Year to you all! Please carefully read over the following key information relating to Year 9 and the Options process.

### **GCSE Options: Tutor Time Support**

**WB 12<sup>TH</sup> January**, the weekly tutor time timetable will be adjusted to support the GCSE Options process and the delivery of key information your child needs to make informed choices.

- On Mondays, students will engage with the **Unifrog** platform (there is more information on this separately below).
- In addition, tutors will deliver key information about some GCSE Options information on offer during Tuesday and Thursday tutor times for the next few weeks.
- Some departments have elected to deliver this information via subject teacher during lesson time.
- Next week, students will be given an A5 booklet to make notes in when they complete their Unifrog activities and to make notes during GCSE Options talks.
- These booklets will stay with their tutors and will be sent home with students in early February.

### **GCSE Options: Key Dates for the Diary**

Please see below for an overview of key dates associated with the GCSE Options process. The electronic GCSE Options information booklet is currently being updated and will be ready in time for the Options Evening.

**There will be a separate communication sent to parents/carers on the GCSE Options Evening (12<sup>th</sup> February) closer to the time.**

- **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February:** students will complete a **mock** MS form to indicate their chosen GCSE Option subjects.
