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Dear Parent / Carer,

We are pleased to inform you that we are organising an **educational visit for Year 11 students to the Silverstone Museum** in October 2026. This exciting opportunity has been carefully planned to enrich students' understanding of business, technology and career pathways within the motorsport and wider STEM industries.

The visit will take place on **Tuesday 13th October and Wednesday 14th October 2026**. As this is a **one-day educational visit**, students will attend on **one of these dates only**. Due to the number of students involved, the trip will run twice, with different groups attending on each day. While the trip is not compulsory, we strongly encourage participation as it provides a valuable and engaging experience that complements the curriculum and broadens students' career awareness.

A key highlight of the day will be an **Exhibition led by industry experts** and a **STEM workshop** offering students insight into career pathways within motorsport, logistics, manufacturing, and further and higher education. This will be a highly informative and inspiring session designed to raise aspirations and support students in making informed decisions about their future. There will be no unsupervised time.

Travel arrangements are as follows:

- Departure from school: **8:45 am**
- Return to school: approximately **3:00 pm**
- Transport: **coach travel**

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£25 per student**, which covers transport and entry to the museum. Although the visit is subsidised and we aim to make it accessible to all students, we rely on voluntary contributions to make the trip viable. **If insufficient contributions are received, we may unfortunately have to cancel the visit.**

We are committed to ensuring the trip is inclusive and will endeavour to accommodate individual student needs wherever possible. Please note that students will be expected to catch up on any work missed during the day, and they must demonstrate the high standards of behaviour always expected of them.

Students may wear their own clothes but should remember that this is a school trip. Clothes should be suitable for the weather and footwear should be comfortable as students will be on their feet for much of the day. Students should bring a packed lunch.
